Expansion of SatAcad to new Communities (\$59,000)

Goal: In AY02, identify two new communities in which to place SatAcad after-school classes, plus expansion for ASE and AWSEM. Begin building partnerships and local infrastructure.

Progress: Gresham/East County and KFalls have expressed interest. Satellite classes program should be in place in East County by summer 2002.

Goal: In AY03, deliver classes programming and other SatAcad activities to these communities, using local instructors and mentors.

Goal: In AY04, see growth in classes in each community, as well as AWSEM clubs and ASE apprenticeships. Begin investigating new community for follow-on funding.

Goal: In AY05, continue to see growth in first two communities, and bring classes to one new community with follow-on funding.
